## **Unbreakable Bond Impressions: Bulk Instructions**



Our Self-Curing Molding Putty is non-toxic, permanent once cured, waterproof, and is heat resistant up to  $400^{\circ}$ F. Pre-cure shelf life is  $\sim$ six months. If using gloves when working with Molding Putty, do not use vinyl gloves. Avoid having the Molding Putty come into contact with anything containing sulfur, vinyl or amines as it may inhibit the curing process.

## **Instructions to Make a Baby Hand or Foot Impression:**

• With clean hands, combine equal amounts of Part 1 (white) & Part 2 (gold) of our proprietary Self-Curing Molding Putty. Mix together by kneading and folding until a uniform color is achieved. See portion chart below for different size molds.

Size of Print	Preemie	Baby	Child	Adult/Teen	Large Adult

<b>Amount of Putty</b>	1  oz White + 1  oz 6  Gold = 2  oz	2oz White $+ 2 oz$ $Gold = 4 oz$	4  oz White + 4  oz $Gold = 8  oz$	6  oz White + 6  oz $Gold = 12  oz$	8  oz White + 8  oz $Gold = 16  oz$

- After the putty is mixed, it has a 10-15 minute work time to make an imprint.
- Roll the putty into a ball and place it inside the Circle, Heart or Oval Mold on an open Patty Pad.
- Using the heel of your hand, press the putty into the mold until it is full and a uniform thickness. *Hint:Wipe* the mold and patty pad with a damp paper towel first to aid removal.
- Close the Patty Pad over the mold and use the heel of your hand to smooth
- Wipe the hand or foot clean with a damp paper towel. Hint: Leaving a bit of moisture on the hand or foot will aid in removal.
- Leaving the putty in the mold, press the hand or foot into the putty, applying even pressure. Hint: Be gentle but firm with pressure as you make the impression.
- Immediately remove the hand or foot from the putty. Check that you have the impression that you want. If not, re-knead the putty and try again.
- Leave the impression flat, on a stable surface, print side up as it cures.
- If desired, use stamps to impress a name or date. You can also press objects into the putty like small hearts, beads, etc.
- Allow 1.5-2 hours for the putty to self-cure. The material is fully cured when you can no longer make an indent in the surface with a nail or tool.
- To remove the impression from the mold, simply peel the mold away from the putty.
- Once the mold is cured, it is permanent. It cannot be melted down or remolded. It can be touched, cleaned with water and dish soap and held as desired.
